Become an ECF Facilitator

REP is looking to recruit experienced DHTs, AHTs and UPS3 teachers who have led on ITT or NQT/ECT developments who:

- Have experience of leading training for staff
- Have a strong understanding of best practice in teaching and learning
- Are able to communicate effectively with colleagues
- Have experience of working with NQTs / ECTs or ITTs
- Are committed to the development of the next generation of teachers

REP is now working with UCL Institute of Education as a delivery partner to allow schools to access the Full Induction Programme (FIP) for our Early Career Teachers (ECT) in September 2024.

To support you in delivering this you will:

- Receive training from REP and UCL on how to deliver the materials
- Use carefully designed content with all the resources needed to effectively deliver these sessions – these will be available on UCL Extend
- Receive support from REP and UCL to deal with questions and concerns, including a termly Facilitators meeting
- In year 1, schools will receive payment for the services of the facilitator at the rate of £50 per hour (approximately 11 hours per term)
- Be part of a dynamic team on this two-year programme with all ECF sessions facilitated between 4 and 6pm
